Public Participation shall be governed by the following rules:

- a. The Public participation period shall be for thirty minutes or fewer;
- b. A participant must be recognized by the presiding officer and must preface comments by an announcement of his or her name, place of residence, and group affiliation, if appropriate.
- c. Each statement made by a participant shall be limited to three minutes' duration;
- d. No participant may speak more than once on the same topic until all others who wish to speak on that topic have been heard;
- e. All statements shall be directed to the presiding officer
- f. The presiding officer may:
 - i. Interrupt, warn, or terminate a participant's statement when the statement is too lengthy, abusive, obscene, or irrelevant
 - ii. Request any individual to leave the meeting when that person does not observe reasonable decorum;

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- iii. Request that assistance of law enforcement officers in the removal of a disorderly person when that person's conduct interferes with the orderly progress of the meeting;
- iv. Call of a recess or an adjournment to another time when the lack of public decorum so interferes with the orderly conduct of the meeting as to warrant such action; and
- v. Waive these rules when necessary for the protection of privacy or the efficient administration of the Commission's business.
